



DIABETES MEDICATIONS - ORAL

| Medication | When To Take |
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| Actos (pioglitizone) | May be taken without food |
| Amaryl (glimepiride) | Take with breakfast or first main meal |
| Avandamet (Avandia + Glucophage) | Take with meals |
| Avandia (rosiglitazone) | May be taken with or without food |
| Diabeta, Micronase, Glynase (glyburide) | Take with 1 st meal of the day |
| Glucophage (metformin) Glucophage XR (extended release) | Take with food to decrease GI upset Take with evening meal |
| Glucotrol (glipizide) Glucotrol XL (extended release) | Take 30m before meal - usually breakfast |
| Glucovance (metformin + glyburide) | Take with food |
| Glyset (miglitol) | Take with meals |
| Januvia (sitagliptin phosphate) | Take once daily., with or without food |
| Metaglip (glipizide + metformin) | Take with food |
| Prandin (repaglinide) | Take 0-30m before meals |
| Precose (acarbose) | Take with 1 st bite of main meal . If taking twice a day, take with breakfast and supper |
| Starlix (nateglinide) | Take 1-30m before meals |
